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WHAT IS EBSCO DISCOVERY SERVICE (EDS)?

- „This is a library scientific discovery tool. It is an easy-to-use and effective tool for searching licensed electronic resources and selected open-access databases.”

WHAT CAN WE SEARCH WITH EDS MULTI-SEARCH?

- e-resources (including scientific articles),
- e-books,
- e-journals,
- abstracts and bibliographic descriptions of publications,
- full-text publications,
- reports, reviews, conference materials,
- open access materials,

EDS also searches::

- subscribed databases (from publishers such as EBSCO, Springer, Wiley, Elsevier),
- subscribed collections of magazines and e-books,
- resources of the PPM-UMW institutional repository,
- some open resources (OA) available on the Internet,

DO I NEED TO LOG IN TO THE MULTI-SEARCH ENGINE TO USE IT?

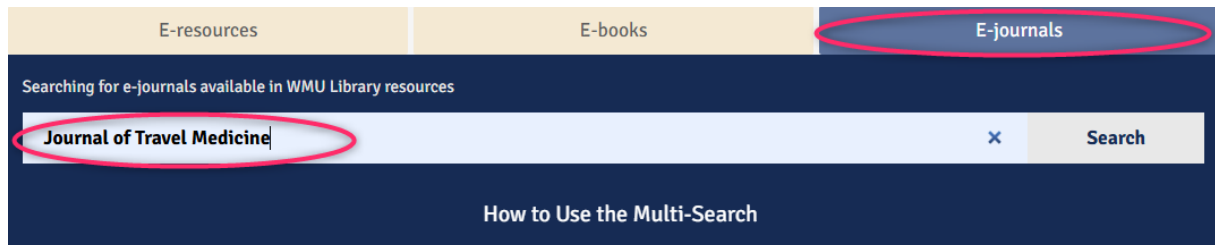
- **BASIC OPTIONS** – Searching in the EDS multi-search engine on the university network works without logging in. Simply visit the [Library website](#) and enter a keyword or phrase in the search field, then:
 - search for publications and browse the results,
 - filter and sort search results,
 - use available full-text publications,
 - cite publications and copy pre-written bibliographic descriptions,
 - send search results to an email address,

- **ADDITIONAL OPTIONS:**
 - Using the EDS scientific multi-search engine from outside the university network (e.g. from home) requires logging in and authorization in the [HAN](#) system.
 - Creating an individual [My EBSCO](#) account allows you to take advantage of additional features, such as:
 - ✓ **Saving search results** – allows you to store selected articles, books and others materials so that you can return to them at any time without having to search again.
 - ✓ **Creating folders** – allows you to organize saved materials into thematic collections, which makes it easier to organize literature for projects, term papers and research.
 - ✓ **Export of bibliographic** – allows you to export citation data to external bibliography managers, such as [Mendeley](#) czy [Zotero](#), which facilitates the creation of citations and bibliographies in various citation styles.
 - ✓ **Saving search history** – allows you to access previous queries to easily return to previously analyzed topics and continue your research.
 - ✓ **Setting e-mail notifications (alerts)** – allows you to receive automatic information about new publications appearing in the database on topics of interest to the user making it easier to keep up to date with scientific literature.

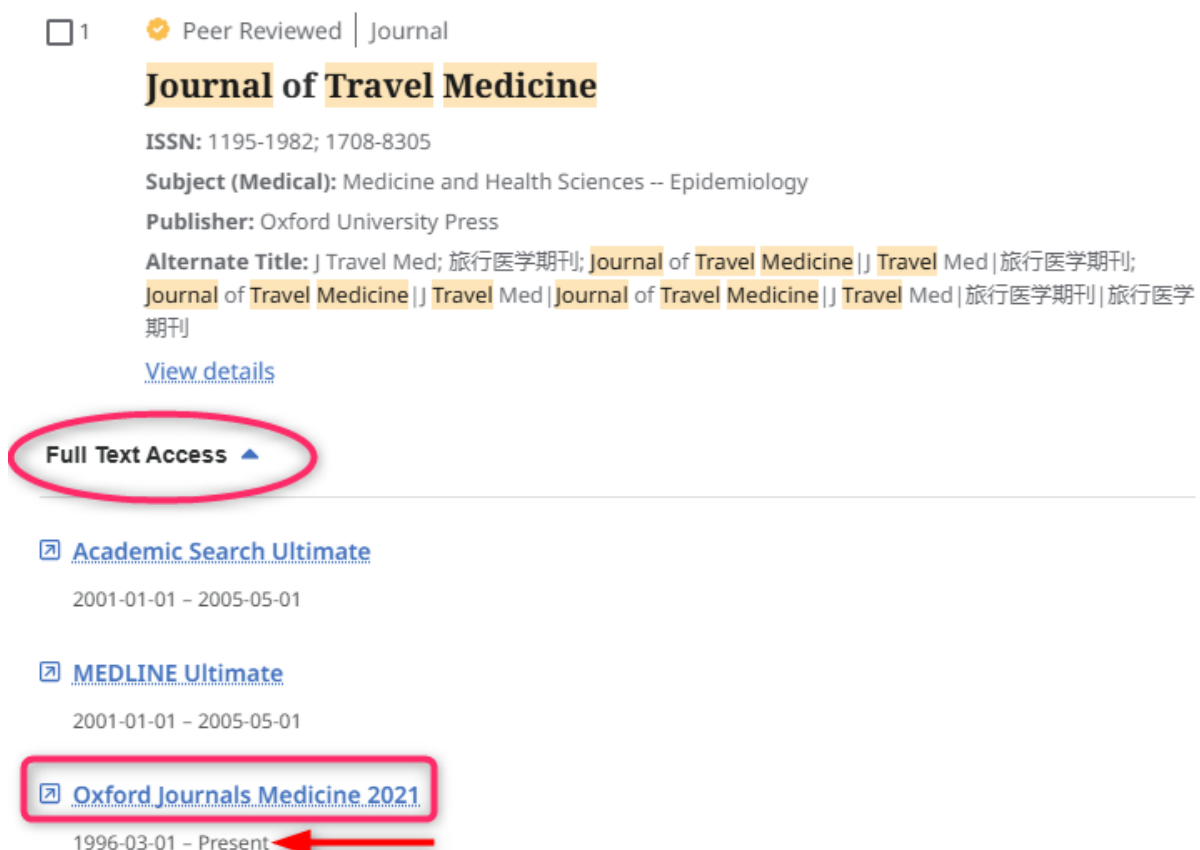
HOW TO SEARCH FOR E-JOURNALS IN THE EDS MULTI-SEARCH ENGINE?

- **E-journals tab** – used to search for specific journal titles.

Click the "E-journals" tab and then enter the journal title in the search box (e.g. "Journal of Travel Medicine").



After clicking "search", a window with search results will open:



Full text access is presented along with information about the platform, publisher, and subscription year range.

After clicking on "Oxford Journals Medicine", a window opens with the "Journal of Travel Medicine", which can then be filtered by date or journal number

WHAT TO DO IF I DO NOT HAVE ACCESS TO THE FULL TEXT OF THE ARTICLE?

- **Embargo** – not all journals and articles are available in open access upon publication. Some publications are subject to an embargo period, meaning that the full text of the article becomes available only after a specified period (e.g., 6, 12, or 24 months). During the embargo period, only the abstract is typically available:

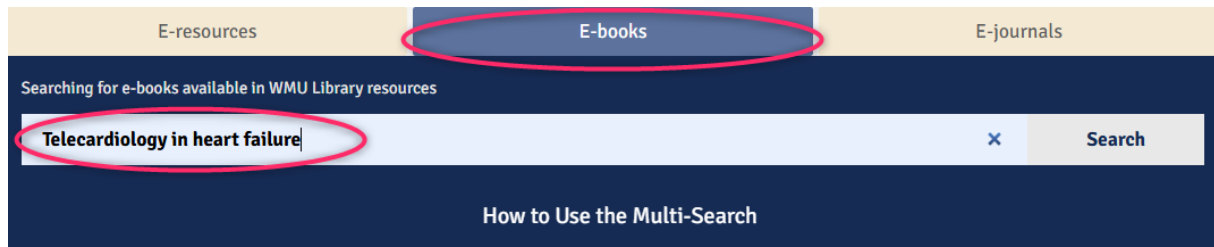

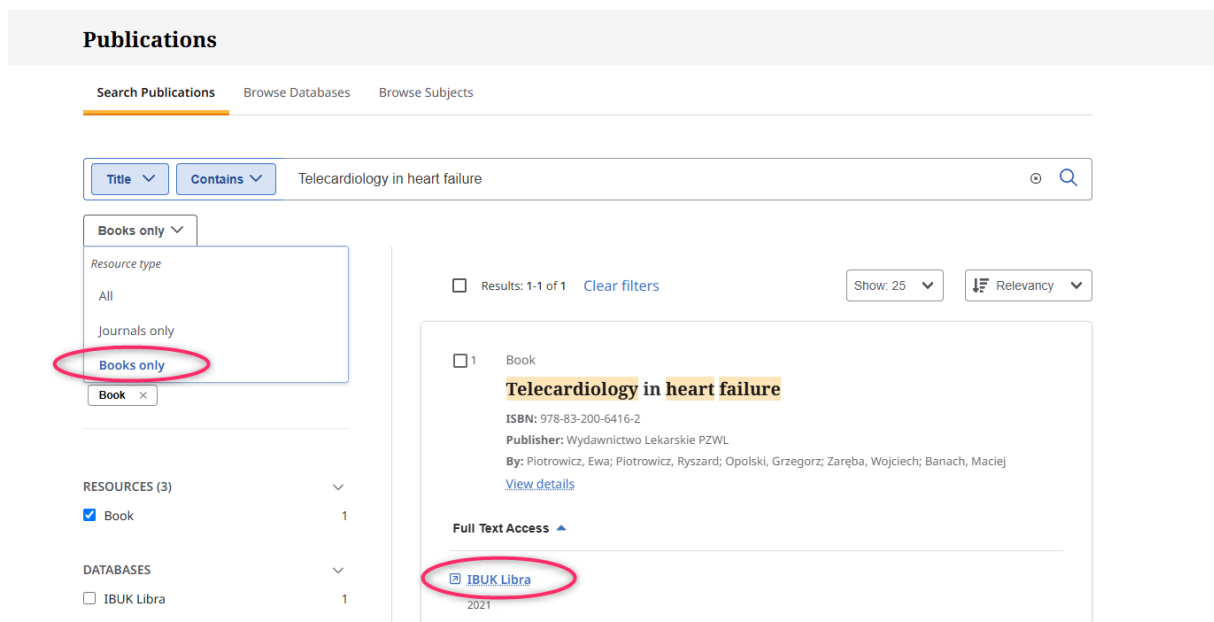
HOW TO SEARCH FOR E-BOOKS IN EDS MULTI-SEARCH ENGINE?

- **E-books tab** – used to search for specific book titles.

Select the e-books tab and then enter the desired book title in the search field, e.g., "Telecardiology in heart failure":



Clicking "search" opens a window with search results and the option to access the full text. From there, you can continue your search by filtering, for example, by resource type:



After clicking on [IBUK Libra](#), you will be redirected to the IBUK Libra platform and to the full text of the book without having to create an account or log in:

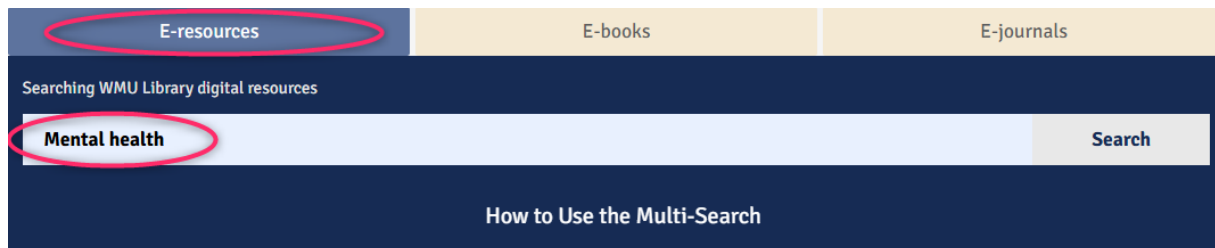

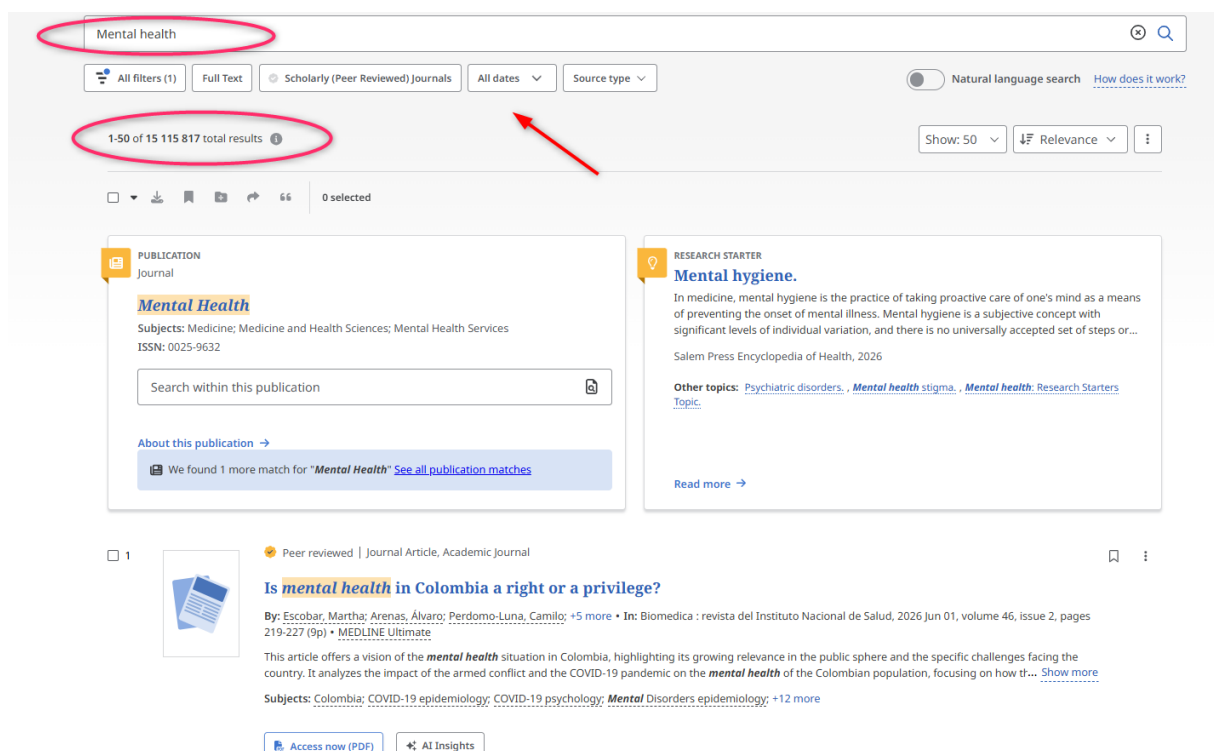

HOW TO SEARCH FOR ARTICLES ON A GIVEN TOPIC IN THE EDS MULTI-SEARCH ENGINE?

- **Simple search** - to find thematic articles, simply click the "E-resources" tab and enter a phrase or topic (i.e., keywords describing the topic of interest) into the main search engine window. These can be single words or short phrases, e.g., "Mental health":

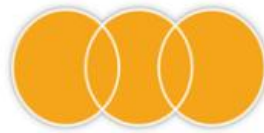


Clicking "Search" will display a list of results, a set of publications related to the selected topic. Filters are available next to the results, allowing you to narrow your search, for example, by publication year, document type (article, book), or language:



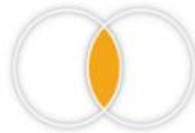
- **Advanced search** - allows you to formulate queries more precisely by combining keywords using logical operators: OR, AND, NOT.

At least one of your search terms appears in the results.
"OR" expands your search scope.



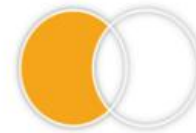
cancers OR neoplasms OR tumors

All search terms appear in the results.
"AND" narrows the search scope



stroke AND depression

Excludes one of the terms.
"NOT" - searches for publications related to "animals" but excluding "rats"



animals NOT rats

- **OR** – expands the results (e.g., "cancers OR neoplasms OR tumors") – searches for all search terms combined.
- **AND** – narrows the results (e.g., "stroke AND depression") – retrieves only those results that contain terms common to the combined sets.
- **NOT** – excludes specific results (e.g., "animals NOT rats") – excludes a given term from the search results.

These options make the search more precise and allow you to quickly reach the most relevant materials.

HOW TO SEARCH BY TOPIC IN THE EDS MULTI-SEARCH ENGINE?

Thematic search allows you to select a specific discipline and access materials without having to enter precise keywords.

- **Thematic search** – used to search for materials based on pre-defined topics (e-journals and e-books).
- **A-Z list search** – used to browse and locate specific journal titles and e-books to which the library subscribes.

Clicking on a selected topic, such as "Agriculture" or "Medicine and Health Sciences," will take you to more specific topics, each of which will be linked to a corresponding list of publications related to the selected topic:

FILTERING RESULTS

Filtering results in the EDS Multisearch engine allows you to quickly narrow down the list of results and access the most relevant scientific materials.

To begin your search, enter a keyword, such as "depression," in the Multisearch engine window and click "Search." Once the results are displayed, filters are available to refine them:

- **Full Text** – limits results to only materials available online in full text.
- **Peer-Reviewed** – limits results to articles published in peer-reviewed scientific journals.
- **Source Type** – allows you to select the publication type, e.g., books, journals, reports.
- **Publication Date** – allows you to limit results to a specific year range.

ADDITIONAL FUNCTIONS

Natural Language Search – allows queries to be formulated in a manner similar to everyday speech, making interaction with the system easier and the search process more intuitive. This feature is constantly being developed and uses artificial intelligence to better understand the context of queries and deliver more relevant results.

The user can use both traditional keyword-based searches and enter full questions or sentences in natural language.

Examples of natural language queries:

- „What are digestive system diseases?"
- „Who is Alexander Fleming?"
- „What is CRISPR technology?"
- „Find information about the book "1984""

AI Insights – allows you to quickly generate concise summaries of scientific articles in the form of a few key points, allowing you to efficiently assess their usefulness without having to read the entire text.
