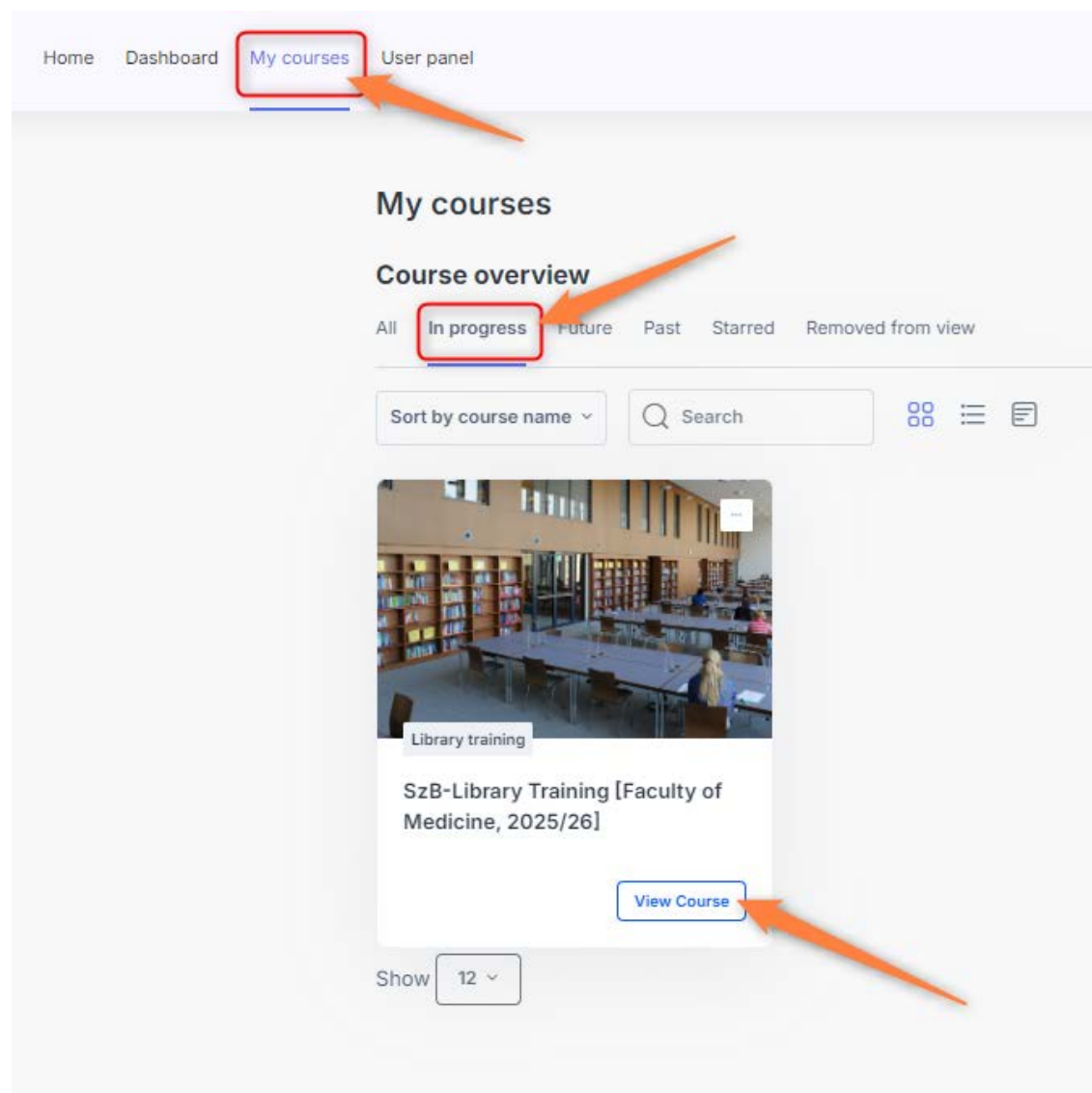

Course Grades Activities

Course description

Library Training is a **compulsory subject** implemented in the form of e-learning, in the amount of **2 hours**.

The training is intended for first-year students of the Faculty of Medicine at the Wrocław Medical University.

The condition for passing is solving the test and receiving min. **60% correct answers**.
Entries in virtual indexes take place after the end of the winter semester.
